2012 SUPER CASH BONANZA CHARITY CAMPAIGN

Information for Districts – Councils – Chairmen – Sellers

Super Cash Bonanza Charity Raffle Tickets and posters will be distributed during the Ticket Distribution Meetings in your diocese the weekend of February 17, 18, & 19, 2012.

Please make sure all who are in charge of the Super Cash Bonanza Charity Campaign at your council read all of the materials provided to the council including the 2012 Super Cash Bonanza Campaign Book.

Significant income for charity can be earned by your council far surpassing the basic rebate of \$2.40 per ticket, but you must adhere to the “rules” as set in the instruction booklet. Some rebates require meeting attendance while others require meeting First Phase and Final Phase quotas. Here are some of the key points:

- A minimum of two members from your council must attend the Diocesan Ticket Distribution Meeting. The two-member requirement does not include the District Deputy, State Directors and Chairmen, or State Officers to qualify for these rebates.
- The sold tickets and one check from your council must be sent to the State Treasurer by the deadlines published. The turn-in dates are Friday, April 13, 2012 and Friday, May 18, 2012. Your council must meet these deadlines with the required number of sold tickets per member in order to qualify for various rebates.
- Most methods of shipping are acceptable. The UPS, FedEx or the US Postal System have a good record of timely delivery of small packages. Please do not send your package by a method requiring a signature to receive it. These often go back to the delivery agent’s warehouse and await pick up. Please use durable-strength envelopes or cartons to avoid damage during shipment.
- Please make every effort to have all of your council’s tickets submitted by the second turn-in deadline. Tickets brought to and delivered at the convention can create a processing problem. The drawing will take place earlier in the evening this year and will leave little time for late arrivals. We cannot guarantee your rebates on tickets received more than a few days after the final turn in date of May 18, 2012.
