Dear Ohio Knights of Columbus,

Did you know that more than 34,000 babies were aborted in Ohio in 2005? Of that number, 2,975 of those abortions were performed within the Youngstown Diocese, 11,200 in the Cleveland Diocese, 6582 in the Columbus Diocese, 366 in the Steubenville Diocese, 3029 in the Toledo Diocese, and a total of 7090 in the Cincinnati Archdiocese?

Recently, your State Pro-Life Director, Gary Anderson, challenged all councils, assemblies, chapters, and individual brother Knights to “redouble our efforts and resolve in restoring the sanctity of human life,” encouraging every council and assembly to work in collaboration with other pro-life organizations already on the front line of the fight for life.

One such prominent organization is Ohio Right to Life, working at the Ohio Statehouse to promote passage of pro-life legislation; working to shut down abortion facilities across the state; educating the general public on life issues through the Center for Life and Hope; screening, endorsing, and supporting pro-life candidates from the statehouse to the White House through its political action committee (PAC).

Ohio Right to Life is willing to make a presentation to any local council, chapter, or assembly updating you on where our state stands in the battle for life, what is being done (statewide and locally) to save more lives, and how grassroots pro-lifers, like the Knights, can make a difference.
