

Francesco B. Iannaggi the first born child of seven to Natale and Lucia Iannaggi on August 31, 1958 Cesaro, Italy

On April 22, 1966 the family immigrated to Cleveland Ohio where they became parishioners of St. Rocco, an inner city Italian Church Community. It was there that Frank attended 1st thru 8<sup>th</sup> grade, made his First Communion and Confirmation. He continued the balance of his education in the Cleveland Public School system where he graduated from Lincoln-West High School with honors, president of the National Honor Society, and captain of the wrestling team. On June 10, 1977, Frank applied for and was granted the honor of American Citizenship. After graduation, he attended Miami University in southwestern Ohio where he studied Architecture and received the Bachelors of Environmental Design Degree.

Relocated to Columbus Ohio, in 1983, to attend Ohio State where he enrolled in a Graduate program in civil engineering. When attending Ohio State he obtained intern employment with the State of Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation. He later became a full time employee and worked as a designer and project manager for the Bureau's facilities, which included the agency headquarters, central parking garage and 21 remote sites. In August, 2004 Frank was promoted to State Wide Operations Manager, where he is responsible for nearly 2 million square feet of office and warehouse space, a staff of 13, the day to day facility needs and long term planning for the agency.

He married Teresa Paul, a coworker, on October 8<sup>th</sup> 1983. They have three daughters, Tara, Kourtney, and Francesca, and one son Nicolas, two son in-laws, Brian and Todd and five grandsons, Devin, Jordan, Brian, Domenic and Keegan. They joined Our Lady of Miraculous Medal parish in 1984 and actively participated in the IHN Homeless project, parish festival committee, R.C.I.A., Children's Christmas Pageant and a host of K of C Parish activities. May 2005 they joined the parish community of Pope John XXIII in Canal Winchester Ohio.

It was in 1993 that Frank became a Knight of Columbus and helped in the founding of a new council, Our Lady of Miraculous Medal 11188, Frank was appointed the charter financial secretary until he was voted in as Grand Knight for two consecutive terms (1996 thru 1998). He was elected Greater Columbus K of C Chapter president in 2001 and is currently the treasurer and a member of the chapter 3<sup>rd</sup> degree team. It was in 2001 that Frank was appointed District Deputy for a four year term and was responsible for the formation of council 13428 Holy Family, in December 2003.

On April 2, 1995 he was initiated into the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree and immediately assumed the roll of Comptroller for Columbus General Assembly 809 where he rose through the chairs of Pilot, Captain, and in July 2000 was elected Navigator. Frank was District secretary to Master Larry Bales from 1996 thru 2000, and area coordinator for Master Don Hall from 2000 thru 2002 and Master Richard Wysong from 2003 thru 2005. As area coordinator he was an integral part of the formation Assemblies 2727 Bishop Edward Herrmann and 2900 John Paul II. Frank was appointed Master of Ohio District 3 September 1 2005 with the establishment of a 3<sup>rd</sup> district, in Ohio.
